

## IRH-281 Two Channel Infrared Headsets

The IRH-281 headsets receive "Hearing Impaired" audio (dialog centric audio at a user adjustable loudness) and "Audio Description" audio (formerly Visually Impaired –Narrative, a description of the movie action to aid



## **Batteries**

When new batteries are needed, remove the battery cover by pushing the tab up and lifting the cover off.



Install AAA batteries with the + (positive) end as indicated above. Re-install battery cover.


## **Adjustable Headband**

Adjust the headband to the size needed for the individual patron by pulling or pushing the ear pieces.



## **Controls**

Use the ON/OFF switch to turn the unit ON or OFF. Adjust the "Hearing Impaired" channel (Volume A) and/or the "Audio Description" channel (Volume B) as desired to achieve a comfortable listening level. The IRH-281 allows a blend of HI and AD to be heard with the mix adjusted by the patron. The monitor switch will mute the
